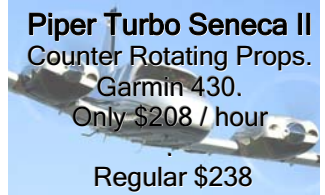

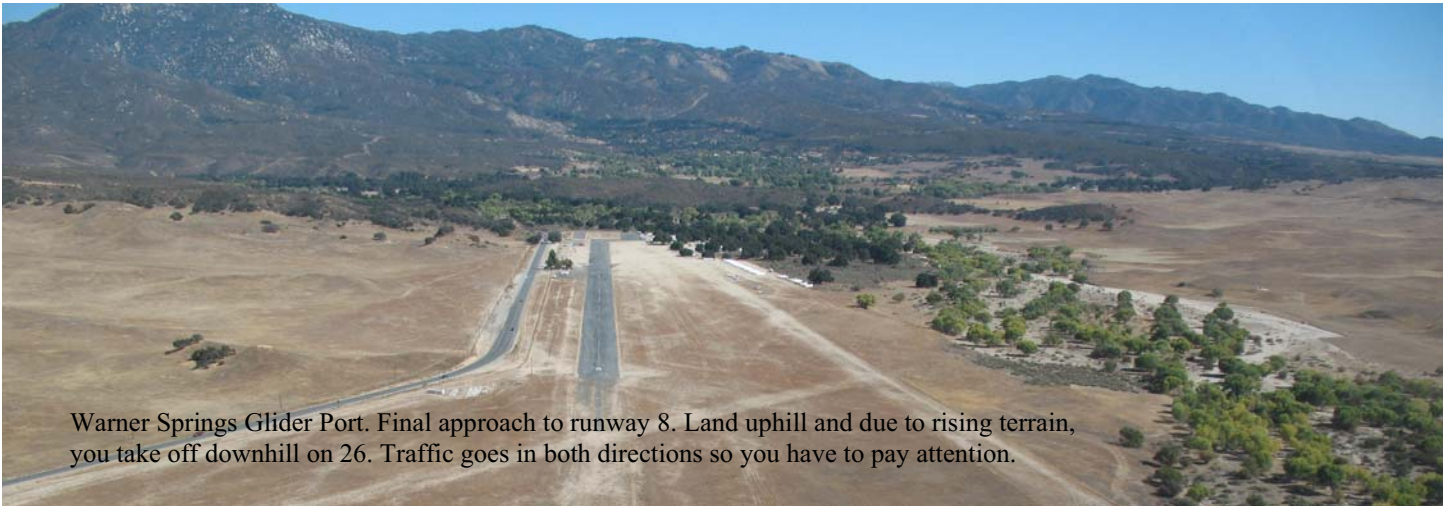

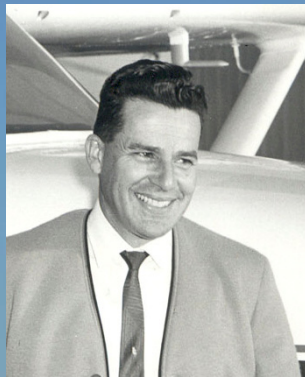
First Solo Flight

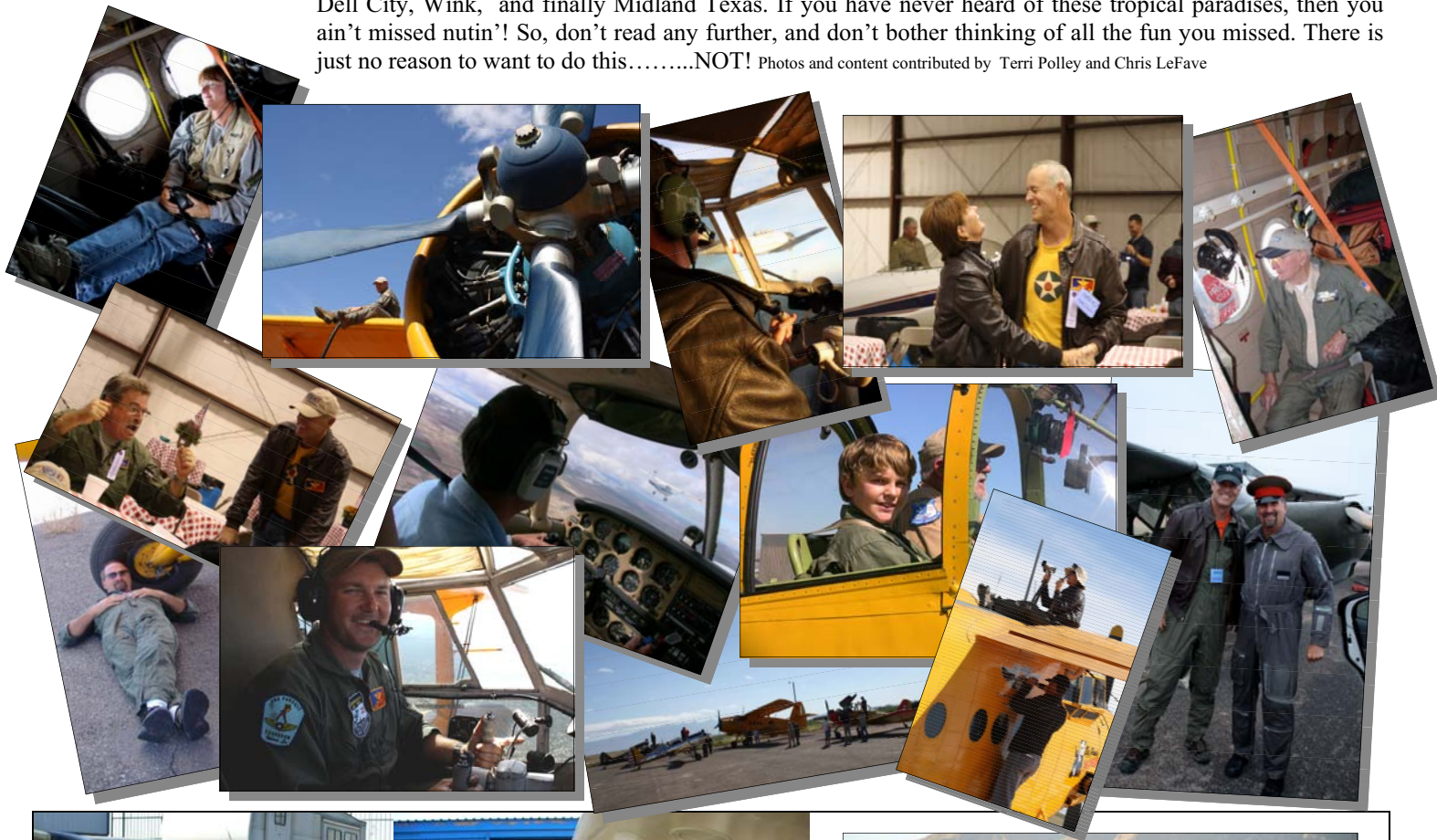
