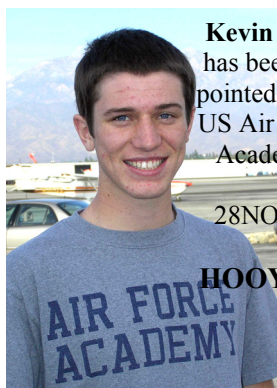

New Sport Pilot Bob Hadley



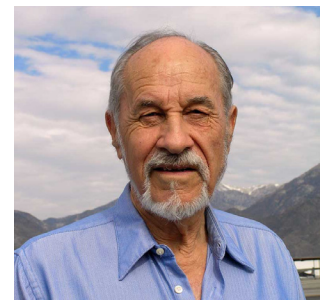
